*Once again this year Sylvia and Gerry will try to keep all curlers and Legion members up to date on what's going on down at your Legion*

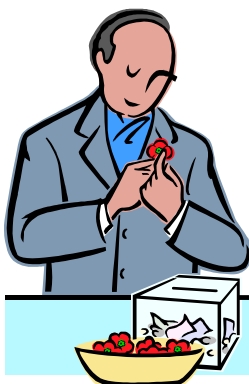
