Rules

1. Eligibility
 - a. Participants must be 18 years of age or older as of Dec. 31, 2011
 - b. Each team is limited to ONE (1) 'elite' player.
 - i. A player is designated 'elite' if the player participated in the Tankard, Scotties, or reached the podium (top 3 positions) in either of the Senior, Masters, Mixed, or Junior Provincial Championships in any of the last four (4) curling seasons.
2. Declaring Your Team
 - a. First game lineup denotes your team (declared at registration)
 - b. Teams can have six players (one male substitute and one female substitute)
3. Team Make-up
 - a. As per CCA and Quebec Curling Association, Mixed format rules apply (alternating shot)
 - b. If, due to injury, a team can only field 3 players, Curling Quebec Mixed rules apply (still must alternate)
4. Substitutes
 - a. Teams requiring a substitute DURING the event can use their declared substitute(s), or they may ask for a replacement player from the "spare pool" via the convenor or Chief Referee.
5. Game Duration – all games are 8 ends.
 - a. Ties
 - i. If bonspiel is round-robin, ties remain
 - ii. If bonspiel is ladder, one extra end is played (if still tied, draw to the button, any player, with sweeping – opposing team cannot sweep behind the line)
6. Last Rock determined by coin toss
7. Time Limit
 - a. We do not have time clocks, however teams are expected to respect the 2 hour time limit. Teams that are slow may be advised to speed up if deemed necessary
8. Delay of Start of Play
 - a. If a game is delayed 1 to 15 minutes due to the late arrival of a team, the non-offending team shall receive one point for the first end and have last rock in the 2nd end. If the delay is between 15 and 30 minutes, the non-offending team receives an additional point for the 2nd end and has last rock in the third end. If play is delayed more than 30 minutes due to the late or non-arrival of a team, the non-offending team is declared winner by forfeit.
 - b. For extenuating circumstances, the Chief Referee can amend rule 8(a) accordingly at his discretion.

9. Tie Breakers and Playoff Seeding (if round robin) determined by “points” – each player throws to the button at the conclusion of their first game
10. Please respect Whitlock’s “No Jeans” policy
